






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
Q2. How often, if at all, do patients describe mental or physical health conditions likely caused/worsened by their housing?



Q3. To what extent, if at all, are you concerned about the impact that poor housing is having on patients?




Q4_Summary. Have you or have you not seen any of these health conditions in patients that you think are caused/worsened by their housing problems?



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
Q5_Summary. Do you think that the following do or do not worsen chronic health conditions and delay treatment of them?





Q6. How often, if ever, do patients describe having to go without using energy because they are unable to pay?





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



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

Q10. How concerned, if at all, are you about the impact of housing on children's health?







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

Q12. How often, if ever, do you see disabled people in unsuitable accommodation (e.g. unsafe or inaccessible) which is likely causing/worsening their ill health?






